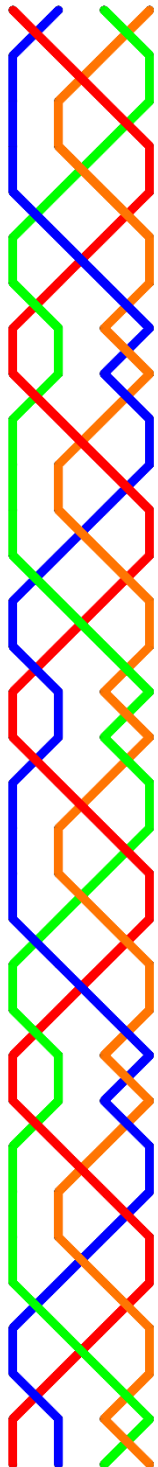


Soay Minimus



Purpose

Soay is a slightly more challenging minimus method.

Third place bell rings a *half hunt* pattern.

The front work is different either side of the treble which may be a new skill.

Treble signposts are helpful and easy to spot.

Ringing Soay Minimus

Treble plain hunts.

Fourth place bell rings a half hunt, only coming down as far as seconds place. At the back, *lie* and *dodge* each time.

Passing the treble at the back is a signpost to *lie*.

Second and third place bells:

When the treble takes you off the lead, make seconds and lead again, making four blows in lead.

At the back, *dodge* and *lie* each time. This *dodge* will always be with the *half hunt bell* (third place bell).

After *lying*, the treble turns you from the back.

Jargon

Half hunt is a bell which does repeated work, which, like a hunt bell, is separate from the working bells. In touches of Grandsire Doubles, one bell is often referred to as the *half hunt bell*.

Lie or *lying* means ringing in last place for more than one blow.
