## Venue

Worcestershire County Cricket Club, New Road, Worcester, **WR2 4QQ**

The venue has two on-site car parks. The one on the east side of the hotel/WCCC (the city/river side) is fee paying. The free car park is on the west side of WCCC towards St John's.

Alternatively, the venue is a short walk (0.5 miles) from Worcester Foregate Street Station, served by trains from Birmingham, London Paddington and Bristol.
