


## **Dodgy Call Changes**



## **Purpose**

Dodgy call changes are ideal for ringers who can already ring call changes but who are yet to move on to method ringing. They offer an opportunity to develop skills of dodging, awareness of place and striking based on a familiar existing skill.

Ringing dodgy call changes simply means that after each call, the bells which are due to change should dodge once with each other (at handstroke), prior to settling into their new place.

As well as being a fun thing for a practice night, well struck dodgy call changes can sound nicely musical as service or wedding ringing.
