## Support the future

Ringing is facing a changing and uncertain future. 40% of ringers are likely to retire in the next 10 years if not before and they represent most of the leadership skills and change ringing experience.

We need to address this by training and supporting new teachers, particularly younger ones.

Our approach to teaching needs to change to meet the expectations of new ringers. Research clearly shows that intensive initial training is most effective and meets expectations. Like other activities an established training scheme with goals, rewards and trained teachers, reflects 'consumers' demand for high quality training as well as supporting rapid progress..

Against this background, the Association of Ringing Teachers was formed on 4 March 2012 to develop and support the delivery, integrity, and standards in the teaching, instruction and education, of the art of change ringing.

We need to train and support the teachers of the future. The ART Teaching Scheme, Learning the Ropes and ART workshops are designed to motivate our teachers, ringers and helpers to make their time in the belfry enjoyable.

ART needs individuals and groups to support our ongoing work to deliver teaching and learning fit for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century.

We need financial support but also time from ringers with admin and other skills to support our work and develop new materials.
