


Reverse Bob Minimus



Purpose

Reverse Bob Minimus enables ringers who are familiar with Plain Bob Minimus to ring it in reverse. If the diagram were to be viewed upside down, it would look like Plain Bob.

There are clear treble signposts.

A new skill is *frontwork* – in this case, dodging on the front in 1-2.

Ringling Reverse Bob Minimus

The treble plain hunts.

If the treble takes your bell off the lead, *lead full* and dodge in 1-2.

On arriving at the front, if the treble is not there, dodge in 1-2, then *lead full*.

Always hunt straight to the back.

If the treble is not there when leaving the back, hunt straight to lead.

If the treble is at the back, make two blows in thirds place under it, then two blows in fourth place before hunting back to the lead.

Jargon

Lead full means to lead for two blows.

Frontwork is a series of pieces of work rung in the first and seconds place of a row.
