


Ashford Little Bob



Purpose

Ashford Little Bob is a short method where the treble plain hunts to thirds place.

If a ringer can already plain hunt on three but has become accustomed to following bell numbers, it provides an opportunity to hunt on three, ringing over four other bells in a changing order.

Because the working bells make seconds and lead again, the treble ringer will easily be able to spot which bell is leading next. This will be familiar when progressing to ringing the treble to Plain Bob Doubles.

The other three bells dodge in 3-4 and 4-5, make long fifths and seconds.

Ringling Ashford Little Bob

The treble plain hunts to thirds place.

The other bells ring the method.

When the treble takes a bell off the lead, it makes seconds and leads again.
