

Stedman Doubles Dominoes

Preparation

- Photocopy the sheets or print the files
- Laminate if possible for durability
- Cut into domino cards along the thick black lines

Using the domino cards

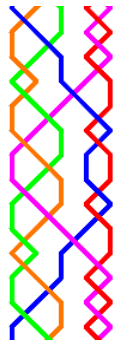
- Make sure that the cards have been well shuffled
- Place them all out on the floor, or table, face up

The cards are going to be used as a simple matching activity with START being the first card. They match the statement on the right side of the domino with the correct answer on the left side of the next domino.

You can do this exercise by yourself but it is best used as a group activity to enable discussion. One experienced ringer as part of the group helps understanding. They should avoid giving the answers.

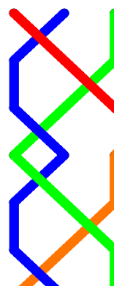
