

## **Hagworthingham Bob Doubles**



## **Purpose**

Hagworthingham Bob is a more intricate method for the working bells. In the plain course, two bells ring repetitive, simple work. It could be rung by a band of mixed ability whilst providing a challenge for more advanced ringers.

The 1 and 3 are both slow course bells.

## **Ringing Hagworthingham Bob Doubles**

The treble rings plain hunt.

The 3 makes alternate long thirds and long leads (four blows).

The 2, 4 and 5 ring the method which includes wrong places in 2-3 and long fishtails in 4-5. Seconds is made over the treble when it leads and fourths is made under the treble when it is lying in fifth place.
