

Boveney Place Doubles



Purpose

Boveney is a simple doubles method, where the ringer of the 2 rings a pattern of places in 1-2. There are clear treble signposts and an opportunity to focus on striking when moving in and out of the lead.

Ringing Boveney Place Doubles

The treble plain hunts.

Second place bell rings the slow course work in 1-2:

- Lead full
- Make seconds (4 blows)
- Lead full
- Make seconds over the treble
- Repeat

The 3, 4 and 5:

- Plain hunt between thirds and fifths places.
- If passing the treble in fourth place when hunting up to fifth place, hunt to lead next time and lead for four blows.
