

## **Yeoveney Bob Doubles**



## **Purpose**

Yeoveney is a more challenging slow course method, both for the slow bell and the working bells.

It provides an opportunity for the ringer of the slow bell to practise wrong dodges and leading in 1-2.

An experienced band will need to ring the other working bells, but there are clear treble sign posts to help.

## **Ringing Yeoveney Bob Doubles**

The treble plain hunts.

Second place bell rings a repetitive slow course pattern in 1-2:

• Two blows in lead, one in second, two blows in lead, one in second, unless the treble takes your bell from lead, in which case make seconds over the treble and repeat the pattern again.

The working bells have a challenging mixture of point leads, long thirds and double dodging at the back in 4-5.
