

Little Bob Minor

Purpose

Little Bob Minor shares some similarities with Plain Bob Minor, but the treble only plain hunts to fourth place. It is an easy progression from Plain Bob Minor and widely rung. There are clear treble sign posts and can be rung using rules.

Ringling Little Bob Minor

Treble plain hunts to fourth place.

If the treble turns your bell from lead, make seconds and lead again.

Dodge in 3-4 unless your bell meets the treble, in which case, hunt straight through to lead.

At the back, dodge 5-6 up, lie in sixth place, dodge 5-6 down, as in treble bobbing.

Tip. If a bell dodges 3-4 down, it will lead and dodge 3-4 up. If a bell does not dodge 3-4 down, it will lead and make seconds over the treble.

Bobs

Bobs and singles are as in Plain Bob Minor.

At a bob:

- The bell about to make seconds runs out and dodges 5-6 up.
- The bell about to dodge 3-4 down runs in to lead.
- The bell about to dodge 3-4 up makes the bob – two blows in fourths and back to lead.

Singles

At a single:

- The bell about to make seconds is unaffected.
- The bell about to dodge 3-4 down makes thirds and hunts back up, dodging 5-6 up.
- The bell about to dodge 3-4 up makes the bob – two blows in fourths and back to lead.
