

## **Longford Bob Doubles**



## **Purpose**

Longford is a challenging slow course method which offers an opportunity for the ringer of the slow bell to practise wrong dodges and places. The other working bells ring a method for which the back work is similar to the St Martin's group.

## **Ringing Longford Bob Doubles**

The treble plain hunts.

Bell 2 rings the slow course:

- When the treble takes you off lead, make seconds and lead again.
- Point in seconds, lead full (wrong), point in seconds, lead full (right).
- The treble will take you off lead again.

Bells 3, 4 and 5 ring the method. The back work is similar to that of the St Martin's group. The frontwork is made with the slow course bell.
